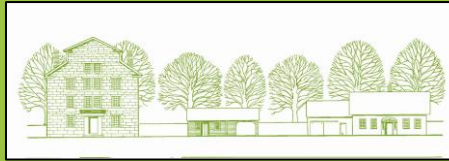

## Each day campers will experience the creative side of history.

The adventure will lead campers through an impressive list of great projects. Campers will have the chance to experience an array of wonderful activities more specific to the Museum in the afternoon, which will include plein air painting this year (hosted by Greater Barton Arts). Our camp will be lead by professional artists and Museum staff. This is a popular day camp, so sign up quickly. Space is limited! Children will love all the learning, adventure and creating that Time Travelers' Camp 2018 has to offer!



## Daily Activities

### Mornings at Camp

**8:30-9 Daily Orientation w/ Camp Mom**, including camp songs, daily schedule and mini-lesson (each workshop will be introduced with an engaging mini-lesson on how the art relates to the history of our area).

**9-12 Rotating Workshops in 40-minute session with a 20-minute snack break.** Workshops are as follows:

**Slate Paintings** Campers will paint scenes of the Museum on tiles salvaged from the Leach Public Library roof. Some finished tiles will be gifted back to the Leach Library for display while keeping others for display at the Museum or going home with children.

**Barn Board Wood Burning** Campers will etch their images or patterns on the barn board wood pieces sourced from historic, local barns. They will be taught how to safely use modern wood burners to finalize their pieces. Finished pieces will be on display or go home with campers.

**Punched Sap Bucket Lanterns** Children will learn how to use metal punches to create an illuminating piece of visual art by reusing old sap buckets from our area. The sap buckets will be punched with holes in a pattern, picture or design then turned upside down with a candle inside.

**Pit-Fired Pottery** In honor of the Brownington potter, Peter Clark, camp staff will teach campers simple pinch pots and other hand-built creations made from terra cotta red clay. Campers and staff will dig a hole in the field behind the Twilight House and pit-fire the pieces the good old-fashioned way.

### Afternoons at Camp

**12-12:30 Lunch and mid-day break** (Time Traveler's Day Campers will be provided with a mid-morning snack and a healthy, well-balanced lunch at no extra charge.)

**12:30-2:30** In the afternoon hours, campers will be able to pre-choose two or three activities that are popular at the Museum. Included in this list of choices may be: Blacksmithing, butter churning, pie-making, basket-weaving, sewing, nature hikes on campus, old-fashioned recess, plein air painting and more!

**2:30-3 Daily Camp Closing Meeting with Camp Mom and parent pick-up**

\*Campers will have the opportunity to sign up for afternoon activities after enrollment.

Campers and their families are invited to a Friday pot-luck lunch, and then are welcomed to travel through the afternoon activities together!
